

Executive Arrangements

Notice under Section 29(2) of the Local Government Act 2000 that the council has adopted revised executive arrangements.

The Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 required the council to consult and draw up proposals for replacing the existing leader and cabinet arrangements. The council at their meeting on 15 September 2010 passed a resolution adopting the "strong leader and cabinet" model under which a leader will be elected by the council for a 4-year term and have responsibility for all of the council's executive functions. The leader will appoint a deputy and other councillors to serve on a cabinet and determine their respective areas of responsibility. The council will retain the power to end the term of office of the leader at any time.

The new arrangements will come into effect on 8 May 2011 following the local elections (on 5 May). In the meantime, the existing arrangements will continue.
