Dog Control Orders

Failing to put and keep a dog on a lead, when directed to do so.

This notice is to inform anyone with an interest that Eastbourne Borough Council has made an Order, which makes it an offence for anyone to fail to put, and keep, a dog on a lead when on designated land and directed to do so by an authorised officer.

The land designated, is all land within the Borough of Eastbourne of the following descriptions, being open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access with or without payment:

Roads, footpaths, road verges, walkways, alleyways and passageways
Beaches, Promenades, Seafront Gardens and walkways
Parks and Gardens,
Recreation and Sports Grounds
Open amenity areas
Surface car parks
Open Downland (including farmland) and;
In all other locations

The Order comes into force on the 14th April 2008.

A map of the areas that are covered by the order may be viewed at EBC's offices at 1 Grove Road, Eastbourne, on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays between the hours of 9am and 5pm and on Wednesdays from 9.30am to 5pm.
